Maharashtra CM to attend Anjuman law college event

MUMBAI: Chief minister Uddhav Thackeray will attend the naming ceremony of the Barrister A R Antulay College of Law on the Anjuman-I-Islam campus near CSMT on Saturday.

Besides Thackeray, NCP chief Sharad Pawar and Congress politician Ghulam Nabi Azad will be among the other guests, said Anjuman president Dr Zaheer Kazi.
