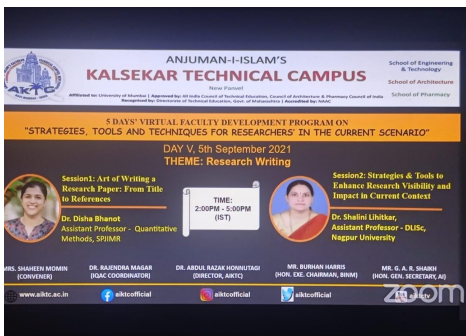

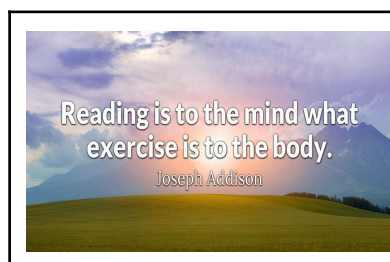

A sudden shock, an unknown, unwanted and a strange situation is what can be used to describe the COVID-19 Pandemic disease presented unique challenges to all the stakeholders of the education system. The sudden and unexpected outbreak of the virus also forced the library professionals to ascertain ways of working in a rapid time frame like shifting to digital platforms wherever possible and to provide adequate remote services to the users.

With a lockdown, there was a sudden spurt of free ebooks, journals, magazines and everyday newspapers on practically every Whatsapp group. There was actually an information explosion. We all like free stuff, no denying that! And so, many messages which contained information about the Open Educational Resources (OERs) impressed us a lot and the real journey towards developing OERs Platform began.

Initially the scholarly freely available resources notably National Digital Library of India (NDLI), Shodhganga-a repository of Electronic Thesis and Dissertation, Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ), Book Boon, Directory of Open Access Books (DOAB) and many more useful for **ENGINEERING, PHARMACY, ARCHITECTURE & HUMANITIES** Education and Research in Digital Environment were identified. Then OER platform is created using Joomla and Google Custom Search Engine. This Web portal is a collection of metadata links of OERs categorised into different types like eBooks, eTextbooks, Research Articles, MOOCs, Digital Libraries etc...

The purpose of creating the web portal is to educate students, faculty members, research scholars, around the world about the existence of OERs protected under creative common license, open access under copyright laws or under copyright free environment.

## 19th June National Reading Day India: A day in honour of P. N. Panicker Central Library organized "Book Review Competitions"

Puthuvayil Narayana Panicker (1 March 1909 – 19 June 1995) is known as the Father of the Library Movement in the Indian state of Kerala. The activities of the Kerala Grandhasala Sangham that he initiated triggered a popular cultural movement in Kerala which produced universal literacy in the state in the 1990s.

June 19, his death anniversary, has been observed in Kerala as Vayanadinam (Reading Day) since 1996. The Department of Education in Kerala also observes *Vayana varam* (Reading Week) for a week from June 19 to 25.

In 2017, Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi declared June 19, Kerala's Reading Day, as National Reading Day in India. The following month is also observed as National Reading Month in India.

AIKTC Central Library organized a book review competition. The competition was open to all students and faculties of AIKTC. The competition aimed at nurturing the reading skills, writing skills and creative skills of the students.

# KAAD - Article Abstract Database

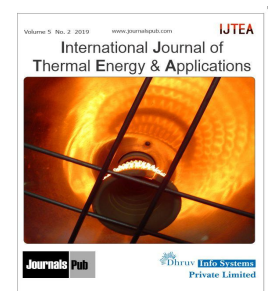

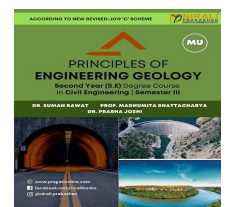
