It is valuable because it offers a quick overview of the article's content and can help you decide if the article will be useful for your research. Remember to cite from the full article in your research though, and never the abstract.

KAAD provides articles with abstract from different periodicals (print form) subscribed by KRRC-Central Library at one place.

Explore the KAAD and send requests for full-text articles. The library will email you the scan copy of the same.


Virtual Bookshelf Service
